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Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

Each year around this time a new group of students eagerly await their turn to join the **Tiger Band Program here in the Twinsburg City School District**. The study of music can be one of the most valuable steps in your child's education. Our experiences in music have convinced us that any child willing to put in a reasonable amount of effort will be successful.

Some of the benefits your child can gain from participation in the Band Program are:

- Increased sense of responsibility
- Mental discipline
- Ability to work together as a team
- Enhanced self-esteem
- Lasting enjoyment and a life-long appreciation of music
- Adding to a well-rounded and complete educational experience

Beginning band class is currently being organized. The <u>first step</u> in the process is to attend the **5th Grade Band Parent Meeting** where the schedule, lessons, and instruments will be explained. Due to the information being discussed, it is important that at least one parent or guardian attend this meeting. The meeting will take place: <u>Tuesday, September 6th, at 7:00 PM</u> in the **George G. Dodge Auditorium**. If you are unable to attend, email and we will set up an appointment time for you and your child. Please keep in mind that to ensure greater student success and to maintain a balanced band, students should be flexible and consider at least <u>two</u> instrument options during this process.

During this brief meeting I will be speaking about expectations for beginning band students, providing information on instrument rental/purchase options, checking used instruments, and suggestions of specific brands to purchase. There will be an opportunity to begin renting instruments at the end of the meeting, so it is suggested that parents/guardians come prepared to rent.

Pellegrino Music Center is the principal company that we deal with for renting. While it is not necessary to contact them before the meeting, their info is listed (pellegrinomusic.com –330-498-8400). There is also additional information about instrument brands on the bottom of this page for those that may not rent. As mentioned above, if you already have an instrument for your student, please consider bringing it to the informational meeting, and we would be glad to look it over for you.

In addition to Pellegrino's Music, there will also be information from a few other local music retailers. Any of these retailers will be able to provide your student with a quality instrument.

## INSTRUMENTS

Every positive factor that we as teachers and parents can contribute to the beginning band student should be considered. It is easy for a student to become discouraged if he or she is using poor or broken equipment. Over the years I have found that the following brands of instruments work best for young players:

Instrument Brand

Trumpet Yamaha, King, Selmer, Conn, Olds Trombone Yamaha, King, Selmer, Conn, Olds

French Horn Conn, Yamaha, King, Olds Clarinet Yamaha, Selmer, Buffet

Saxophone Yamaha, Selmer, Conn, Buescher

Flute Gemeinhardt, Yamaha, Selmer, Armstrong

Percussion Ludwig, Pearl, Dynasty

Snare Drum Sticks Vic Firth SD1
Mallets Musser M24

Unfortunately, some non-music companies create instruments that are not of a reliable quality. These instruments break down easily, and many retailers are hesitant to repair them.
